Mission Statement: Poverello House is a private, nonprofit, nondenominational organization that serves the hungry, the homeless, and the destitute of Fresno, California.

Services Provided:

Meals - Poverello House serves hot meals 365 days a year. Breakfast is served Monday through Friday at 8:30 AM and Saturday and Sunday at 9:00 AM. Lunch is served Monday through Friday and Saturday and Sunday at 12:00 noon. Dinner is served Monday through Friday at 5:00 PM.

Rehabilitation - Poverello House offers rehabilitation services in a drug and alcohol free environment. Intake interviews are currently held on Mondays and Thursdays at 9:00 AM.

Social Services - Poverello House provides a variety of social services to our clients and is always seeking ways to expand those services in both quantity and quality.

The Holy Cross Clinic - The Holy Cross Clinic at Poverello is a free medical and dental clinic that serves the homeless and those without any type of health insurance.

The Village of Hope - The Michael McGarvin Jr. Village of Hope is a community of homeless people who stay in temporary shelters on Poverello property.

Naomi's House - Naomi's House provides overnight shelter to single, homeless women. The shelter is a collaborative effort among three organizations: Poverello House, Marjaree Mason Center, and Holy Cross Center for Women.
